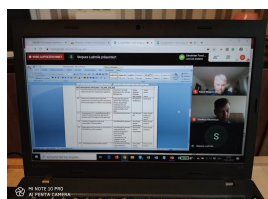
Field Day In Kirovograd Region

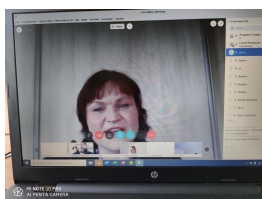

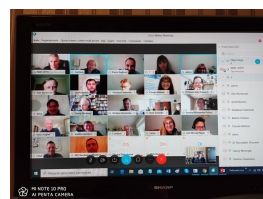

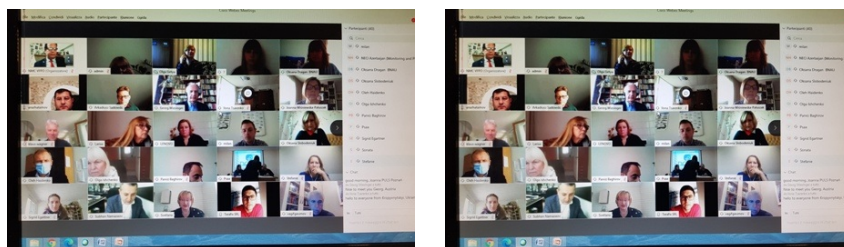
