Green Care Austria - Targets

- fostering understanding of nature and agriculture through farm related activities
- inspiring children and young people for agriculture and forestry, healthy nutrition, animals and nature
- using the positive impact of nature on human health through farm animals and plants (farm pedagogics, health, social counselling, on farm and forest kindergartens)
- developing innovative and qualitative supplements to the existing offers in the educational, social and health sector

Green Care Austria - Targets

- provision of social services in rural areas
- social integration and social work (elderly persons, mentally and physically disabled, psychiatric clients, drug addicts, convicts etc.)
- specified therapies on farms (animal assisted intervention, horticultural therapy)
- supporting people in problematic situations towards (re)integration into society
