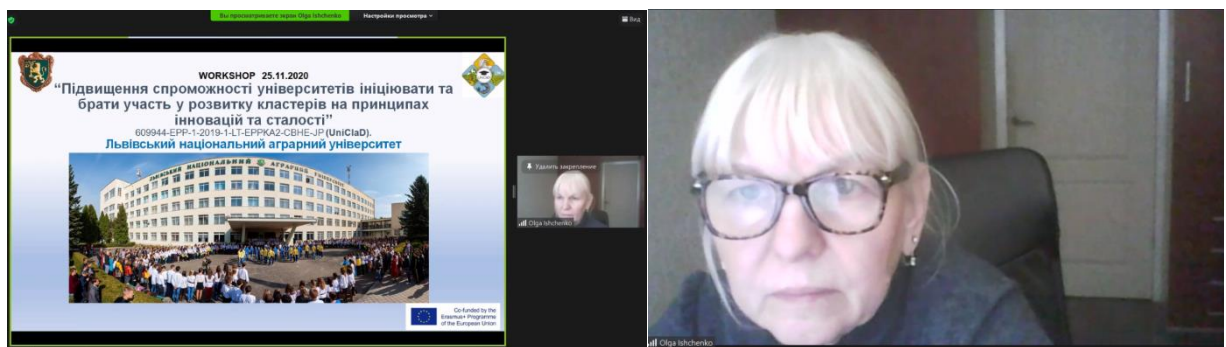

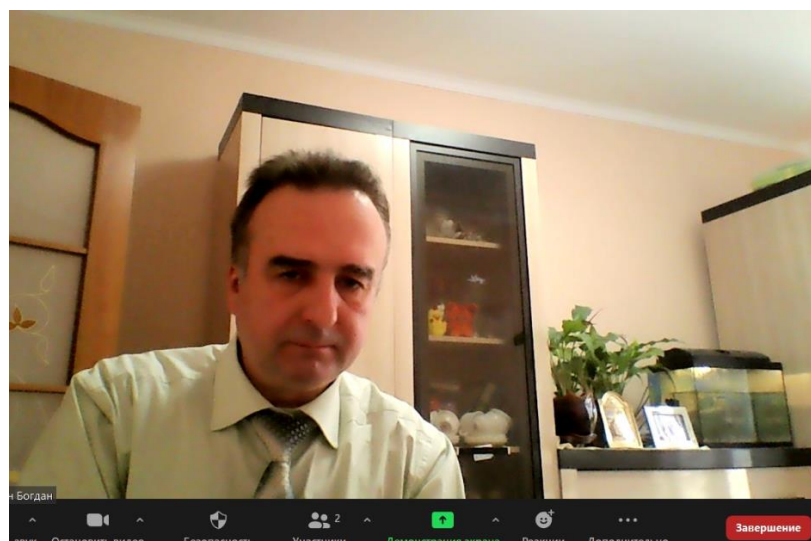
"Recreational resources of conservation areas and their role in the development of tourist clusters"

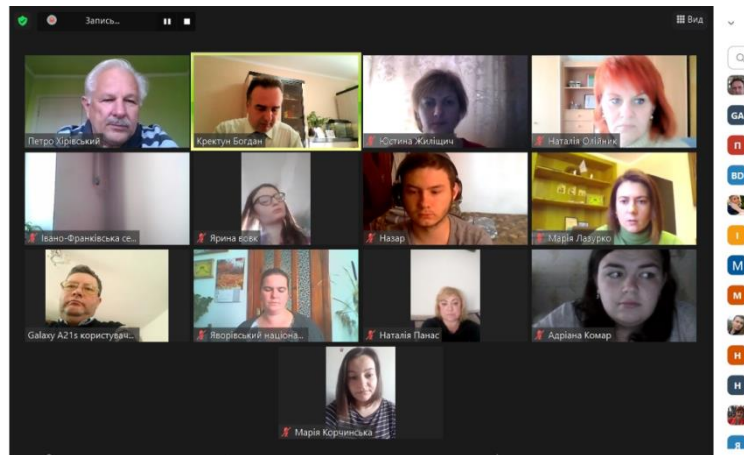


The presentation of the subject of *UniClad project* was made by *Bohdan Krektun/ Associate Prof. of Ecology Department, LNAU*.



He explained that the purpose of the *UniClad project* is the development of university capacities to create and to participate in the development of different types of clusters bringing together business

environment - universities – local authorities. Key tasks is to promote agro tourism clusters initiatives in the region with the involvement of different stakeholders such as other educational and scientific institutions, farm houses, tourist agencies, national and landscape parks, local administrations. He concluded that as a result of webinar the meeting participant will be able to formulate the list of problematic questions that should be studied and will benefit the next meeting.



Prof Petro Khirivskiy(LNAU) described the main ways of involvement into the project the different departments of Lviv National Agrarian University. He described the close collaboration of the department of Ecology with Yavoriv National Nature Park and Regional Landscape Park "Verchnie Dnister Beskids". He analyzed main educational components of curriculum which can contribute to development of student competence in different forms of sustainable tourism.

Topic of his presentation: Curriculum of the specialty 101 "Ecology" and its role in the training of students in ecological, green and agricultural tourism.

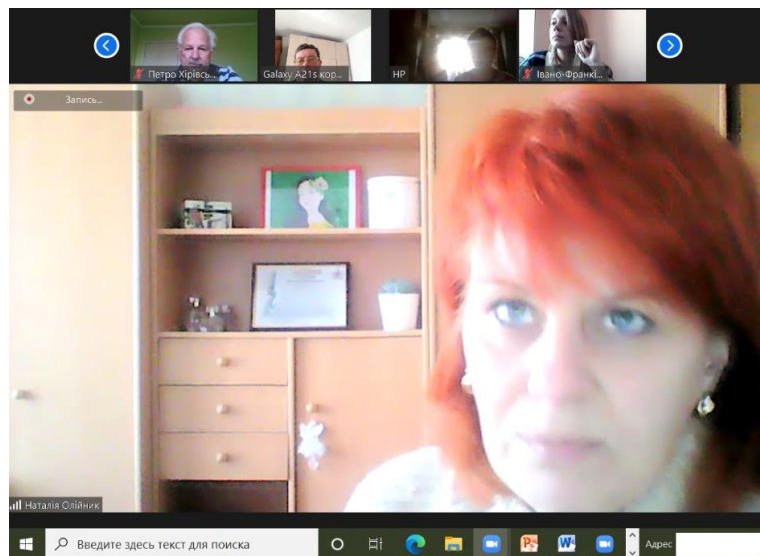

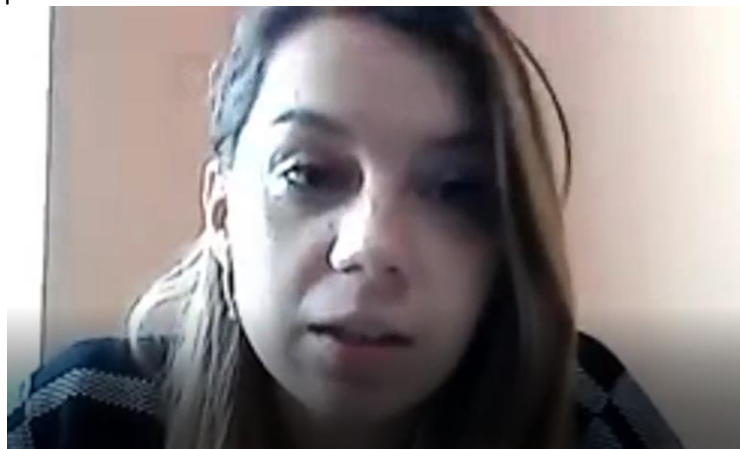
Topic ^ Recreational resources of Yavoriv NNP and their involvement in the development of the tourist cluster”.
